ORGANIC COTTON

Furthermore, it is spun and produced without using toxic chemicals. It is harvested completely by hand, thus maintaining the purity of the fiber that makes the fabric much softer and more durable. The use of organic cotton is beneficial in many aspects, from healthy and environmental aspects, to social aspects, since it favors small farmers and the small local economy. Organic cotton crops use fertilizers of biological origin to enrich the soil. In addition, irrigation water management is much more efficient, using up to 50% less water. They are also hypoallergenic, perfect for sensitive or atopic skin.
